ENGLISH

Expectations

Children will be able to communicate in ENGLISH, using the correct sentence structure and vocabulary words learned throughout Units 1 to 13.

Contents

School, Play time, Family, Parts of the Body, Living Things Grow, The World Around Us, Clothing, My House, Animals, Community Helpers, Means of Transportation, Means of Communication, Food.

Also, at the end of the year they will recognize, read and write all the letters of the alphabet visually and by sound, learning how to read and write short words and sentences. They will be able to recognize the characters and order of events in a story.

Evaluation

Diagnostic/Formative: Children will take High Frequency Words Dictation at the end of every unit.

MATH

Expectations/Contents

Students will learn to write numbers from 1 to 100. Practice counting by ones, twos, fives and tens. Also they will master one digit addition/subtraction. They will learn problem solving skills and describe and extend different patterns. At the same time they will be learning about geometric shapes, fractions, money, time, position words and measurement.

Children will learn everything mentioned before always using their math manipulatives and hands-on activities.

Evaluation

Diagnostic/Formative: At the end of every chapter, students will take a Chapter Review Test to assess how well they have learned the material of this chapter.
